2. A mind all logic is like a knife all blade, it makes the hand bleed that uses it

Logos was considered as a high virtue in humans in Ancient Greek thoughts. Aristotle considered Logos as a desirable characteristic trait in man. Logic, which the ancient Greeks called Logos is a powerful fuel which made the journey of human civilization possible. Logic is the fire which kindled

curiosity in man to know the unknown. In that pursuit man discovered fire, wheel, mathematics to atom bomb, artificial intelligence powered vehicles and supercomputers. Logic has promised increasing standards for human innovation as each epoch passes by. Logic shows man's ability to think, to comprehend, to question, to criticise and to analyse. It is a reflection of ingenuity.

Logic is present in animals too.

Their behaviours of hunting, escaping, marking territories, grouping show their logical abilities. The major factor which differentiates man from other living beings is his sense of mindfulness, his inner conscience emanating from his mind.

Just as man is expected to have logic, he is also expected to have emotions like compassion, sympathy, Benevolence, Righteousness. He is expected to be ethical and moral since humans were also moral beings.

The morals and ethics as a guiding source for human behaviour is an idea given by Scottish Enlightenment thinkers like David Hume. For him, compassion and love propels humans to act in a certain manner. It was in stark contrast to Kant who solely focussed on reason as a guide for behaviour. The presence of such contrasting ideas and theories suggest logic is not the only basis for man's behaviour, there are other factors as well.

All logic and no ethics makes man a dull being. A mind all logic is like a knife all blade, it makes the hand bleed that uses it. A blade can be used in multiple ways. A blade which can be used to elicit pain in person can elicit pleasure by making them look good through the act of shaving. It is the compassionate, ethical and responsible use of blade, not mere logic, which

ensures the blade does not harm the customer
as well as the hair dresser who is using it.

One wonders, if logic is seen
as a virtue, if it has helped in human
progress, then why is a mind full of logic
not desirable. It is because it leads to logic
overload. It makes one appear too rational.

Many a times, highly rational people are seen
as hawkish - working for reasons without any
emotion. They are seen as "Machiavellian",
justifying the means to achieve the ends. This
makes men appear as selfish, negatively
influencing their image.

Similar to the outcome of being
Machiavellian, logic overload has led to
construct of a new identity known as "Nerds".
The term itself is derogatory as it creates a
new set of divisions in human beings. "Nerds" are
seen as highly logical, always invested in
acquiring knowledge. They are characterised

by social loneliness, anxiety because people find too much logic too boring. They are seen as "Robots with human characteristics."

Many a times, such people go into depression and other source of mental health issues due to the social ostracisation. Perhaps too much of logic hampered their social life.

Not everytime logic leads one to be a "nerd". Sometimes person's logic helps him to be social like Socrates. Socrates sacrificed his life for the sake of logic and knowledge. Through his idea of dialectics, he ensured logic spreads and permeates to the darkest corners of Greek society. However his never bending attitude towards logic and overemphasis on logic made him to drink hemlock resulting in his death. His logic was against the established norms and ideas of Greek society. This made

his logic a blade which bled his hand, leading to his demise. Perhaps if he would have given some space to understand emotions, beliefs, he would have lived a bit longer, reforming the society he wished to do.

Socrates's life shows why logic can bleed the hand that uses it. Logic seeks to disrupt and creatively destroy the existing social order which might be built on irrational stunts. The powerful and the mighty who benefit from this feel threatened from logic. Thus they seek to eliminate those who wield logic. This explains why the British sought to suppress the leaders of freedom struggle who broke the foundation of "Benevolent Despotism".

A person who ignores the social and ethical aspects of human lives, taking a decision solely based on logic suffers from guilt. His heart and hands bleed. Though Robert Oppenheimer, the father of atomic bomb built the bomb solely driven by

logic, later his life is full of guilt. His hands were smeared with blood all over.

His eyes become lifeless when he says "I have become death". He invited criticism from all over world, including Gandhi ji who termed it as most diabolic use of science. A decision taken by a mind full of logic, ignoring the conscience made Oppenheimer's future miserable.

While a mind all logic makes the hand bleed of the person who uses it, it also bleeds others who are subject to the decisions solely based on logic. Recently, there was a starvation death in Jharkhand because the beneficiaries of the Public Distribution System had not authenticated their AADHAR. The excessive focus on rules and logic, ignoring the compassion and pain of starvation led to denial of their rights.

The Jharkhand death is just one of the many instances which have been caused due to Bureaucratic apathy and lack of Emotional intelligence. The ill effects of excessive logic was given by Max Weber through his "Iron cage of Rationality" whose public welfare is reduced due to excessive focus on logic.

Perhaps if logic was to be the only driver of decisions, then the world would not have seen philanthropic activities through charities and foundations. It was the concern for others, the pain of the sufferings of others which guides people to donate. It guides organisations like UNDP, Bill and Melinda Gates foundation to ensure well being of all. It ensures malnourishment in Sahara is controlled, it ensures floods in Pakistan are controlled. If logic were to be the only component in mind, the society would have bled continuously without healing itself.

The most important discovery and progress humans made in this decade, turning it into decade was artificial intelligence (AI). logic binds Man and AI together. But ethics, righteousness and compassion separates them. The world fears AI today because its only logical, not humane. The fear of discrimination, prejudices, AI colonisation arise due to lack of values in AI. It shows that excess of logic is bad for society. This is the reason why the countries are going forward with the idea of "Responsible AI", "AI for All" to fill AI with values and righteousness.

However, logic can also heal the hands that have bled, it can heal the society. Baba Sahab Ambedkar and his community have been bleeding due to

caste based discrimination and untouchability.

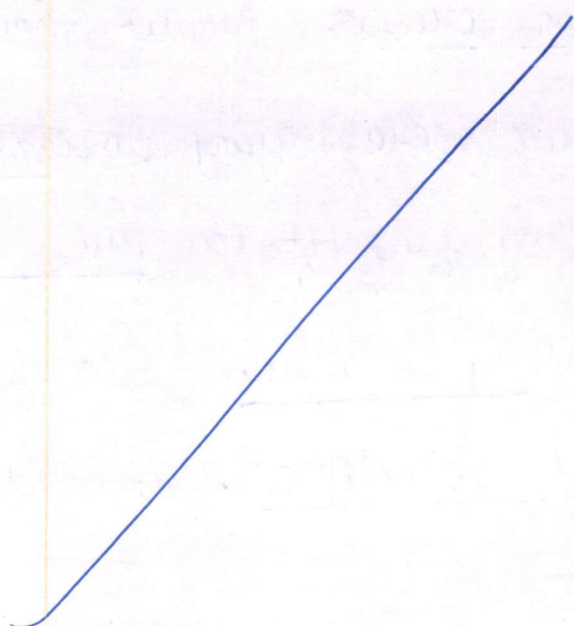
It was Baba Saheb's use of reason and logic which broke the myth of varnas, enabling a dignified life for the erstwhile lower castes like Mahars. Today the logic based decisions of Baba Saheb Ambedkar in form of affirmative action act as a band aid to heal the wounds of the poor, the destitute and the last person standing.

Similar to caste based untouchability, menstrual taboo has seen another form of untouchability. Women are subjected to various forms of discrimination for their biological differences. They are not allowed to sit with others, socialise. They even don't have access to menstrual hygiene products and healthcare. It was the force of logic by the women self help groups, government and public spirited citizens which has reduced this taboo, making women's lives more better by ensuring care while they bleed.

logic also prevents rash decisions and actions. Humans make mistake when they are emotional, driven by passion. They fail to take note of the surroundings, the critical inputs leading to actions which might harm them. Logic prevents such harm as it guides humans to take rational actions based on circumstance. Logic prevents a man from taking vengeance from someone who has done wrong to him. Thus logic also prevents bleeding of the hand that uses it.

Summing up, it is clear that Man should follow the Eight fold Path of Buddha or Aristotle's Golden Mean - the path of moderation. Man must balance between reason and ethics, logic and compassion to ensure best possible outcome.

A mind having balance of logic and emotion prevents extremes of actions. Just as the life on earth was made possible due to Goldilocks condition, human creativity and ingenuity comes to the best fore when the Goldilocks of logic and emotion is achieved. increased. The shadow cast over the disadvantaged sections' lives has just got bigger.

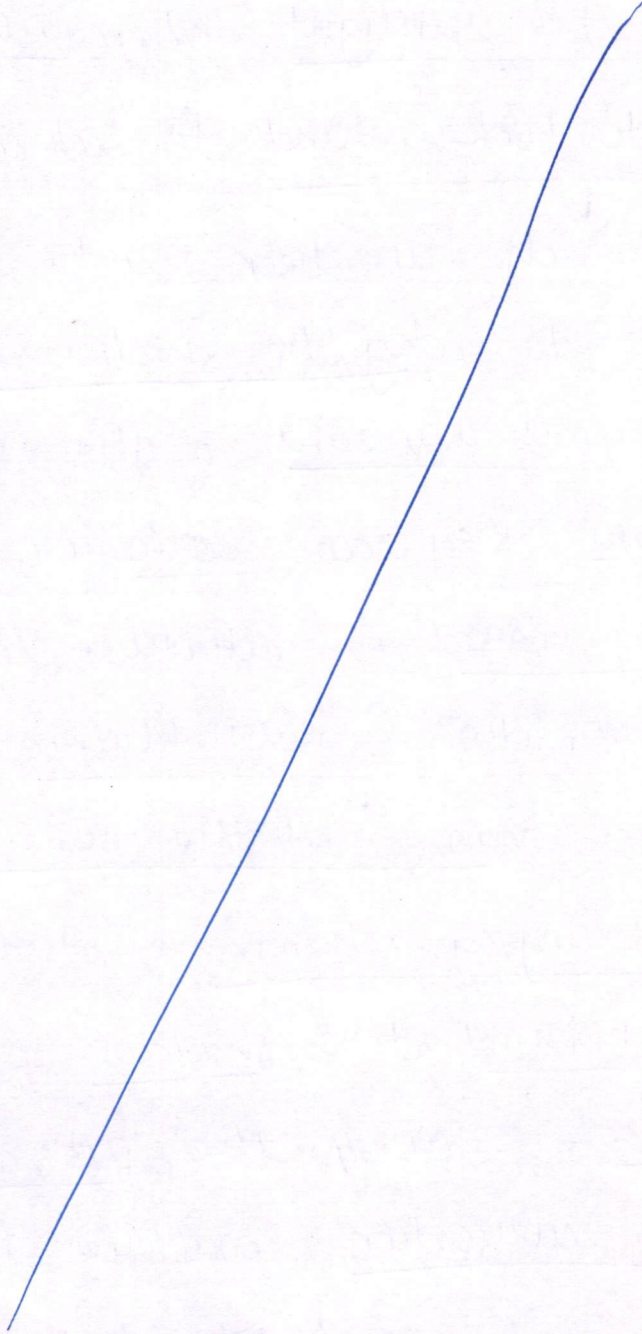

aspirations of future generations

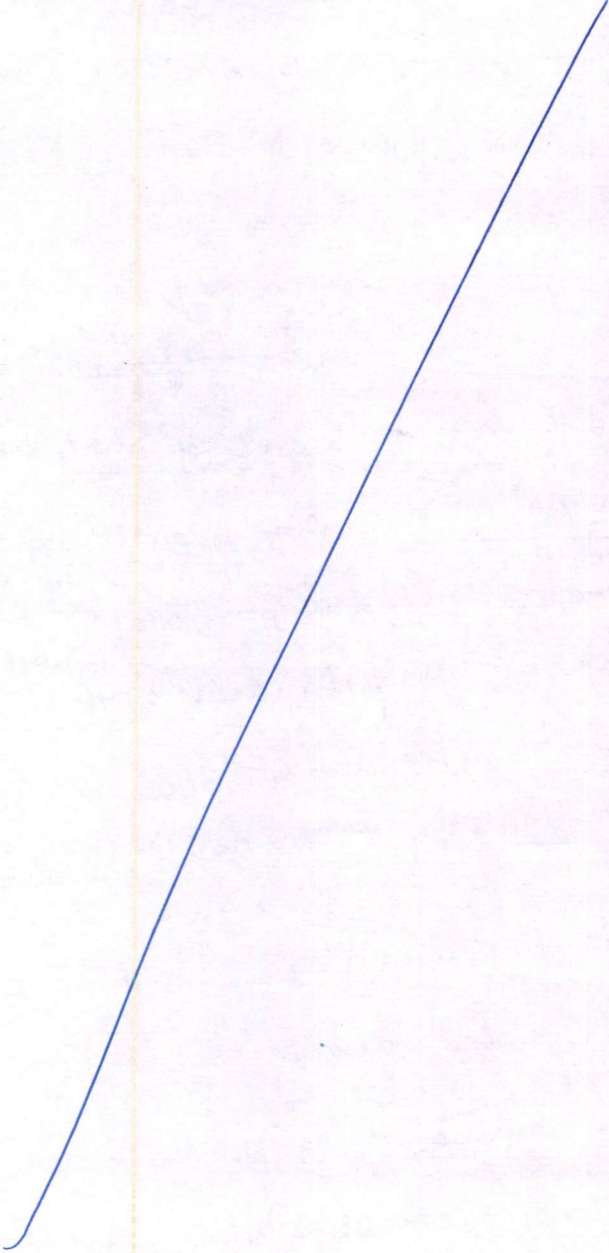
