it became a butterfly

Arunima Sinha, born in 2010, was
a national level volleyball champion. One day
while travelling in a train, she was
thrown out by ~~some~~ miscreants for
resisting a robbery. She survived the
night while 49 trains went past her.
Later, she became the first female
amputee to climb mount everest.

Just when the world was
over for her, where she became disabled
in the eyes of others, she discovered
a whole new world open for her.
She decided to play the toughest game
of life and chase mountain climbing. She
later went on to become the first
amputee to climb all seven highest peaks
of every continent.

Her story resembles to that of a
caterpillar who starts to feel lost and
give up in the face of adversity. But
once it persists and pushes hard to
survive, it finds its true value and
becomes a beautiful butterfly.

It becomes pertinent to ask what
does a caterpillar and butterfly signify?
How does the transition occur from a
caterpillar to a butterfly? Are there any
cases when the transition fails? Are
caterpillar and butterfly relative? And

how does one become a butterfly in their own lives?

A caterpillar refers to a person who is a "work-in-progress". A person who is trying hard to achieve something substantial in life through continuous learning process. While, a butterfly is a state of achievement, success, peace or tranquility. It is achieved through constant efforts and persistence.

Transition from caterpillar to butterfly

To become a butterfly, it becomes essential to identify the traits that a caterpillar must possess to overcome a tough world.

The path of continuous learning provides an avenue of change when the situation seems difficult. As whole India celebrated

the success of chandrayaan 3 and a
successful soft landing on moon's south pole,
one must reflect on the learnings that
ISRO had post failure of 2019 mission. Had
the team given up post the failure, we
could not have witnessed Pragyan rover
roaming as a butterfly on the moon

Secondly, defeats, struggles and
adversity are a part of this transition.

As Steve Jobs had said

"Getting fired from Apple was one
of the best things that could have
happened to me"

He used the time to develop his skills,
work on innovative ideas and come back
stronger to become CEO of Apple again.

The one who persist ultimately become
a butterfly in their own domain.

often, the journey becomes tough due
to a strong enemy. Like my caterpillars

Could be in the race of becoming a butterfly, a person or a team could face a tough opponent. In such cases, what becomes essential is not to give in till the last moment.

For instance, in 2007 T20 world cup, the match equalled on the last ball to come to a super over. It was the fore-sight of a leader like ms Dhoni that the team fought till last ball.

Similarly, it's also essential to accept and embrace change for this transition and not to think that world is over. As India embraced 1991 economic reforms of liberalization, Privatization and Globalization, the economy became resilient and pushed through balance of payment crisis. It eventually became a powerful butterfly economy of world as fifth largest aiming to be a developed country by 2047 in Amrit Kaal.

All that glitters is not gold

Often times, the transition from a caterpillar to a butterfly is not successful and the weight of tough word crumbles down a person.

This could be attributed to an attitude of giving up in the face of tough situations. It could also be due to lack of willingness or lack of foresight of coming challenges. The reason that British were able to dominate India in 1700s and 1800s was the lazy attitude of later mughals and internal rivalry. It led to an external force taking advantage and becoming a butterfly in a third country.

Secondly, over ambition and hubris makes a person oblivious to the situation where she/he is over involved in own wisdom and does not make

effects on time. The fall of business tycoon like Vijay malaya, Ramalingam Raju (satyam) and Chanda Kochare reflects their negligence which does not let them stay on top of success. They eventually become caterpillars in their domains.

Thirdly, one who takes negotiable advantage of the world once they become butterflies also do not stay on the path of success. The classic comparison of APJ Abdul Kalam vs AQ Khan depicts this dichotomy. While Abdul Kalam became ISRO chairman and later country president igniting "wings of fire", AQ Khan lost all his glory as he sold nuclear secrets to other countries.

It depicts that staying on the course of right path ethical and moral actions are pre-requisite of becoming a butterfly or to remain a butterfly.

Are caterpillar and butterfly related?

Often we face struggles and success on a daily basis. This is because the path of the transition from a caterpillar to a butterfly is far from linear. The ability to get up after every struggle also makes it easy to tread on the path of success.

Our moods and emotions reflect the conundrum in the best way. At one moment we can be happy and joyous, the other moment may bring misery. The use of emotional intelligence becomes important in such cases to bring balance between the two extremes of life.

Secondly, humans always pursue Success (butterfly) as epitome of achievement. But we often fail to see that there may be hidden win in losing as well. Bhagat Singh, Rajguru and other freedom fighters dedicated their life to the cause of nation's freedom. They may have gone,

Yet they ignited the spirits of thousands to come out in the freedom movement and become butterflies of India's victory.

Having realized the importance of becoming a butterfly and achieving success, it becomes pertinent to ask as to how does one become a butterfly in their own world?

The first step is to follow three cardinal principles of Patience, Perseverance and Perseverance. Patience of waiting to become a butterfly. Perseverance to hold on to the path in the face of challenges and Perseverance of actual hard work and dedication in becoming our very best in our respective domains. It was the importance of these three values that made Ira Singhal first differently abled Upsc topper.

Secondly, the importance of a right mindset and attitude should be

realized from the beginning. As the saying goes

"Tough situations do not last
Tough people do"

It was the right mindset of some men who led India to victory in 1971 war despite situational crisis and enemy prowess.

Similarly, one needs to believe in themselves and be fearless in the midst of adversity. Often times, self belief gets shaken when the winds and turbulence of negativity are high. Yet, it can be won over by faith in one's own capabilities. India's capability to design indigenous vaccine in the midst of COVID-19 led to it successfully winning over pandemic and coming out as a resilient butterfly.

One can also have a mentor or a guide who can provide direction and guidance when the world seems over.

It was Arjuna's wise teachings that helped Arjun become his best version and aim for the target.

Lastly, one should be willing to help others on their path of mission. It becomes essential for humans to be humble, grounded and gentle when they achieve success and have means to help others. Buddhisatvas delay their own nirvana to help others tread the difficult path of progress.

This is because a beautiful butterfly shows that even though it has wings to fly to any place, yet it remains rooted to its nest as a symbol of humility and wisdom.

We are all caterpillars in this Journey of life. All of us aim to be butterflies. Yet those who become and achieve the taste of success are the ones who sail stronger in the winds and

aim for the shore. As it is rightly said -

"when the going gets

you cannot see a shadow

On 6th February, 1925, the clock of
Manchester United ground was stopped at
5:50pm when their plane crashed.
Their team was returning from a match in
Munich. Twenty on board did not
survive. Even the team's captain
perished in the disaster.

They had an option post the event.

Either form the team again or give up amidst the loss. Yet, they decided to always look ahead from that day onwards. The team was formed again which later gave champions like Christiano Ronaldo.

The above incident highlights that how keeping face to the sunshine amidst the challenges help in continuing on the path of growth and overcoming shadows of defeats.

In this essay, we will explore what is meant by sunshine and shadow? why keeping face to the sunshine is important? what shadow does to us that it should not be seen? Can shadow also become important at times? And what should one do to always keep looking at the sunshine?

Sunshine refers to any situation, circumstance or event which helps in achieving success, growth and peace.

Sunshine for a child could be his ability to write alphabets. Or for an army veteran could be the safety of his troops.

Wide shadow refers to a negative outcome or a situation which one wants to ignore so that the target always remains Success. A shadow could be a failure in an exam that motivates a person to work harder and achieve sunshine of success.

Sunshine! a treasurehouse of growth!

To keep pace to sunshine, it is essential to ponder over what does sunshine bring to us? Firstly, it helps in maintaining a positive attitude. Always looking at solutions rather than problems bring a sense of mental calm and avenues

for improvement. It was this positive attitude of Reserve Bank of India that helped maintaining growth amidst the rising inflation post-pandemic. While the western economies have crumbled under negative growth and high prices, Indian economy has successfully remained an exception.

Secondly, sunshine also gives us hope. Hope of better times.

maybe the best of things
And no good thing ever dies"

- Andy Dupresne

It was this hope that led India to win 1983 world cup, belying the prediction of magicians.

Similarly, looking at sunshine also leads us to the path of change and change for good. Back when Lal Bahadur shastri condemned USA attack

On Vietnam, India was suffering food shortage with the withdrawal of PL-480 program. It was then decided to become self sufficient leading to Green Revolution. And that change is continuing to this day when we are talking about evergreen revolution and nutritional safety and security.

Is shadow a pandemic?

While the benefits of sunshine are infinite, the shadow is equally disturbing as well as leads to losses. Shadow takes us back to the path of orthodoxy and reduces all the progress that has been made so far. It is said by experts that the COVID-19 has taken us back by 10 years atleast on the path of sustainable development goals. As we do not want to go back to a phase without computers, internet, mobile etc, we certainly

do not wish to go back to poverty,
inequality and economic divides.

Secondly, shadow can also be reminding us of our past mistakes. While it's important to learn from mistakes so that we do not repeat them, reminiscing over past mistakes equally is problem causing. As it slows us down. Similarly, holding back negative emotions and judges against someone can also be a shadow of negativity.

Thirdly, shadow also makes all the changes made so far redundant and obsolete. The debate over old Pension scheme vs New Pension scheme has made many states reverse back to old Pension. This not only impacts fiscal stability of the country but also puts an extra burden on future generations.

Paradox of sunshine and shadow

While we all celebrate the growth made so far and always look for sunshine of progress, looking at shadows sometimes is equally important.

While we see economic growth, equality and development, equally important is to address social cleavages, women harassment, child abuse and rights of transgenders.

Dr BR Ambedkar had achieved the highest echelons of success and became the father of our constitution, yet he focused on reducing shadows of caste discrimination, marginalization of vulnerable.

Similarly, in the aim of achieving material sunshine of wealth, status and stature, we have ~~been~~ become focused on

consumerism, hoarding of resources
which casts a spell of shadows on
equitable distribution of resources as held
by directive principles of state policy.

Open, the sunshine of development
makes us so ambitious and greedy, that
its repercussions creates multiple shadows.

The rise of social media was envisaged
to bring people together, share information
and make the world a global village.
Yet the negative implication of fake
news, paid news have resulted in
a shadow of infodemic as held by
Sowmya Swaminathan (WHO scientist).

Shadow can also be a side effect
or a byproduct of sunshine. For instance,
electoral bonds were brought in to
reduce muscle and money power in
election. Yet they have been marred
with allegations of lack of transparency.

This shows that both sunshine and shadow can be relative at times. One must look at sunshine then to achieve growth where shadows do not have an impact. It becomes pertinent to ponder as to what must be done to look at sunshine always?

At an individual level one should develop self awareness, empathy, and will to succeed. This will not only help in own success but bring together everyone. Focus must be on doing good deeds and following minimalism to reduce the shadows of life.

At a societal level we should promote morals and ethics for the new generation. Family is the first agent of socialization that teaches the virtues of patience, trust, harmony. A society

that follows sunshine in form of
less violence, more discussion can
cast away the shadow of hatred and
crime

At the national level, nation must
try to achieve equal and inclusive growth
which reduce shadows of discrimination
and inequality. The very idea of
Atmanirbhar Bharat was to bring
promote
sunshine of self dependency,
industrial growth and make economy
resilient.

often the result of this growth
may not benefit all sections of society
equally. It also leads to lack of
efficient allocation of resources. Here, the
sunshine law of Right to Information helps
in promoting good governance.

At the international level, countries must follow sunshine of promoting environmental friendly policies, reduce decarbonization to enable a healthy earth. The initiative of a small country of Bhutan to adopt Gross National Happiness and shun fossil fuels paves the way for others.

Equally important is to promote peace and disengagement at global level so that shadows of war, conflict and disasters can be minimized. An array of collective efforts are needed to bring sunshine of global growth, mutual trust and harmony amidst the shadows of negativity.

As sunshine nurtures and promotes growth of plants, sunshine of positivity, and a will to succeed can make human life more fulfilling and worthy living.

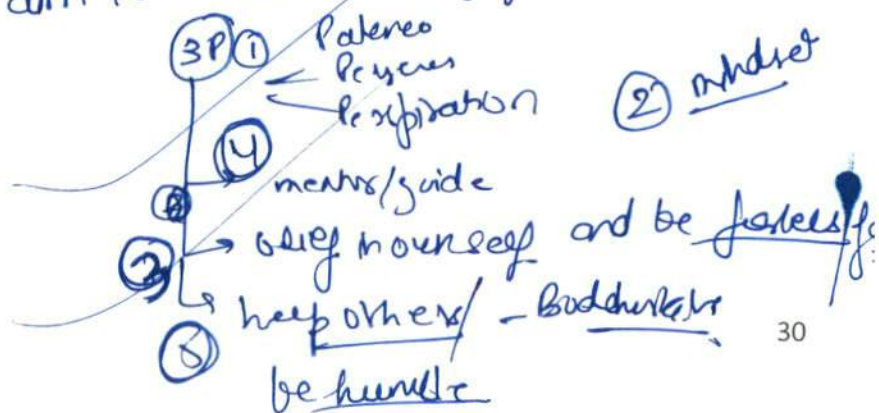

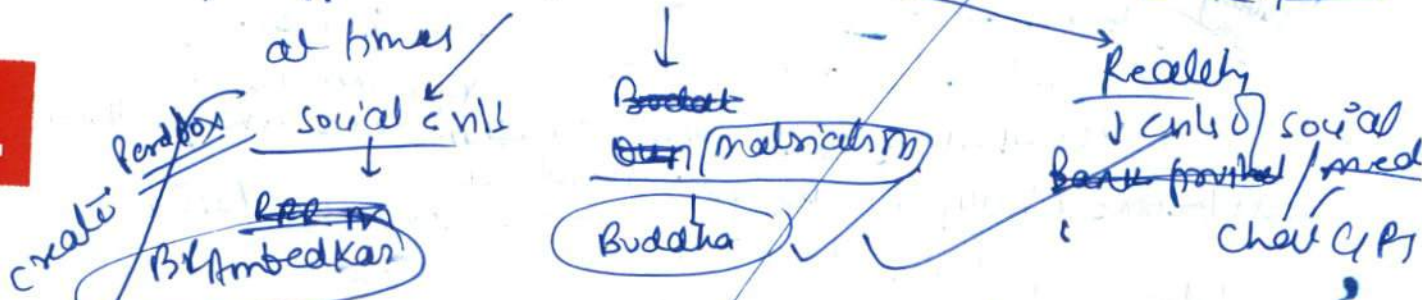
