"When they came for the Unionists,
I kept silent because I am not a Unionist.

When they came for the communists,
I kept silent because I am not a communist.

When they came for the Jews,
I kept silent because I am not a Jew.

When they came for me, nobody
helped because nobody was left to help me."

These are the famous
lines etched on the holocaust
memorial in Germany. It is a
stark reminder of the need to
work together against injustices, else
the entire world can crumble down.

Even Martin Luther King

called for the world to work together in unity. He said, "Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere."

In this essay, we will explore what are the benefits of working together. Whether working together is easy? What are the roadblocks? Moreover does working together always leads to benefit of the world?

Our ancient folklores are replete with stories that highlight the importance of working together. One such story was as follows. On seeing his children fighting, the father showed his children how easily ~~one~~ a single wooden stick

breaks by snapping. However when 4-5 sticks are kept together, the bunch of sticks become unbreakable. This adage has conveyed to every Indian children the idea—'United we stand, Divided we fall.'

There is a strength in unity and world's greatest tyrants can be dethroned when people work together. Britishers were aware of this, and thus adopted a 'Divide and Rule Policy'. Lord Curzon infamously said, "I want to divide the nation in such a way, that a Hindu soldier does NOT think twice before shooting a sikh or muslim."

Realising this strategy, M. Gandhi arrived in India in 1915 and unified

many different voices of extremists, moderates, communists, capitalist, women, marginalised section into one. It was essentially this unity of working together against Britishers that led to India's freedom in 1947.

Separated in time and space was another man Nelson Mandela who mobilised his entire nation into working together against the unjust apartheid regime.

Even after becoming the President of S. Africa after spending 27 years in jail, he did not seek revenge against the erstwhile apartheid govt. He tried to unify the nation using sports, and even established

Truth and Reconciliation Commission.

Similarly, at the height of injustices being met out against black people in USA, there were people like Martin Luther King who advocated for working together against injustice. This was quite remarkable especially when there was widespread discrimination, racism, systemic violence against black Americans.

He gave his famous speech at Lincoln Memorial, Washington USA and said

"I have a dream that one day my kids will be judged by the content of their character and not the color of their skin".

His incessant works led to Black rights movement and systemic reforms

in a crumbling socio-cultural landscape of USA.

Not just in the social sphere, there have been heroic acts of soldiers working together in conflict zones to uphold the ultimate tenet of humanity.

The famous 'Brown-Stigler incident' in World War 2 is a testimony to this.

On realising that the USA's B17 bomber being flown by Charles Brown was damaged and had injured soldiers inside. Franz Stigler (German) in his fighter jet escorted the plane to safety. Thus showing that world can work together despite the differences.

However, in the contemporary world there are rising instances of war like Russia-Ukraine war

), Israel - Palestine War. They have been devoid of any international collaboration to end them. This has led to > 40,000 deaths in Gaza strip.

Moreover these wars can spill over in the entire region or even lead to World War 3. Thus highlighting that if the world fails to work together it will not work at all.

Similarly in the domain of Indian polity, this united work of diverse people has led to immense innovations. This has ~~safeguarded~~ safeguarded rule of law, human rights, and even constitutionalism.

Our Indian Constitution is a prime example of people working together. The constituent assembly worked

for over 2 year 11 months and created the world's most elaborate constitution. This robust Indian constitution has ensured the continuity of democracy in India when the neighbouring nations like Bangladesh, Pakistan, Nepal have faced multiple crisis.

Even our judiciary has given out judicial innovations like Basic Structure Doctrine which has stopped the Parliament-Judiciary conflict. Now these institutions work in harmony to uphold citizen's rights. Thus highlighting the benefits of learning to work together.

However the world's foundations are not just based on collaboration

of working together. It has also been shaped significantly by Global Competition.

At the height of cold war, there ~~was~~ emerged a competition between USA and USSR to reach space.

This was known as the Space Race.

This space race led to first manned lunar mission - 'Apollo'. On touchdown, Neil Armstrong famously said, "one small step for man but one giant leap for mankind." Thus highlighting the importance of competition.

Even Charles Darwin in his book: 'The origin of species' gave the 'Survival of the fittest Principle' which shows that organisms in ecosystem

compete for resources, and the most fittest of them survives.

on a similar note, a healthy competition between various firms in a market economy leads to increase in choices for the consumer. Thus competition ^{also} leads to benefits of the people.

Having discussed various benefits of collaboration / working together and competition. Let us also discuss some adverse impacts of working together for unjust causes.

Caste based groups have emerged due to high social capital within the community.

Regionalism manifesting in son of soils movement, local job

5 → quota laws of Haryana, etc.

These two examples highlight when people work together for unjust cause, it can be antinational and further lead to social fragmentation.

All in all it can be concluded that today world faces unique challenges of climate change, increasing protectionism, Wars, cultural conflicts. These issues need to be urgently dealt with through global collaboration. Otherwise we risk the world falling apart. Moreover we must speak up, and act together against injustices so, 'when they come for us, we have everyone to help us.' {Holocaust memorial}

A young IAS probationer lives a lavish life in Pune district, Maharashtra. She drives an Audi car, has privileges like separate office, staff among other things. However her arrogance and disrespect leads to a complaint being filed by the District Magistrate. This event marks a watshed in her life made on a bed of lies.

The scrutiny leads to nationwide attention. This was none other than ex-stubble IAS officer Pooja Khedkar.

Her lies about her OBC certificate, PWD certificate, number of attempts, etc helped her travel around India as IAS. However, ^{when} ~~the~~ truth put on its shoes, her lies was exposed and she was terminated from her post.

This little anecdote highlights that while lie can travel halfway around the world, but when truth comes out, it leads to a halt of lies.

In this essay we will discover the reasons for increasing lies? What all does a lie include? Issues created by lies. Finally we will explore some solutions to curb this menace of lying for good!

We live in an ever connected globalised world, where we know who is the president of USA but do not know who our neighbour is.

With the emergence of ICT revolution, the world has become a global village. Everyone is connected with everyone now.

Not to mention the dominance of social media, media has significantly increased. Moreover with the coming of smartphones, affordable data (through 4G revolution) has further increased accessibility to information.

Culmination of these factors has given birth to a new era of

Post Truth, acc. to experts.

Some instances in recent past point out to such situations where lies have travelled across globe.

Recently in Olympics 2021, the Algerian boxer Imane Khelif faced the wrath of this misinformation epidemic. People peddled lies about her gender identity, despite International Olympics Committee giving her a green signal.

Indian Athlete Dutee Chand also faced a similar wrath in 2016 Olympics.

This epidemic of lies & fake news is also due to

anonymity provided on social media. This is misused by people who end up becoming peddlers of lies.

Furthermore many social influencers on youtube, facebook, instagram make fake videos due to lack of accountability mechanisms against them.

Similarly during Covid-19 there was largescale rumour mongling on social media regarding origins of virus, vaccine related fake news. This was all put to rest by our frontline warriors spelling out the Truth.

□ Issues caused by lies: The Damage!

Acc. to Bhagwada Gita, the words are like arrows coming out of your bow. Once released, they

can not be taken back. Thus, the damage caused by lies is irrevocable.

Historically, the colonialism in India was based on the lies of 'White Man's burden' and 'colonialism in India's interest.' For many years, Britishers exploited India, by peddling such lies.

However truth put on its shoes when Dadabhai Naoroji gave his famous 'Drain of wealth theory' in which he claimed, "The Britishers soaked wealth from the banks of Ganges & dumped it on the banks of Thames."

• Even in contemporary world,

many corporates are employing Greenwashing Techniques to lie about the environmental impact of their products. For instance, H&M in 2022 was exposed for selling normal t-shirts labelled as 'eco-friendly'.

Thus when the Truth came out it not only burst the bubble of lie, but also led to reputational damage for firm.

Similarly Volkswagen committed a dieseldate scandal and lied about emissions coming out of their vehicle's tailpipe. The truth not only exposed the fraud, but also led to financial damage to the company as they were banned in several nations.

Lies on social media also

stoke the fire of Communal strife
This was visible in Nuh violence
of 2023, when some incendiary posts
on facebook created a communal riot
in Haryana's Nuh district.

Not just this, even
such lies supplemented by the
powers of Generative AI can be used
as a weapon against women.
For instance, NCRB has reported increase
in instances of revenge porn.

Such Gen AI created
content can also impact the
sanctity of elections in a democracy.
In Argentina's election, 2024, the current
president Javier Milei created a fake
image of opposition in communist

attire. This severely affected the election outcomes there.

Many feminist scholars like Simone de Beauvoir, Maya Angelou have exposed many lies about women's incapacity.

□ A stitch in time saves nine

Therefore it's high time for the gout., citizens to take a collective action against lies. Some of the measures needed are as follows:-

Value laden education can go a long way in teaching kids about the adverse effects of lies.

Moreover, epics like Ramayana teach the moral lesson of - 'victory

Truth over ~~facts~~ lies? Such
epics should be taught to young
kids.

Apart from this strengthening
the legislative structure to curb
the menace of fake news is also
needed. In this regard IT Act, 2000
and IT Rules, 2021 have been enforced.

On top of this we need a
Code of ethics for Media to stop
Yellow journalism and improved
International collaboration to ~~spread~~ ^{prevent}

the lie from travelling half way around
the world.

Moreover giving space
to diverse view points is also needed

to allow different versions of Truth
to come out. There is a very famous

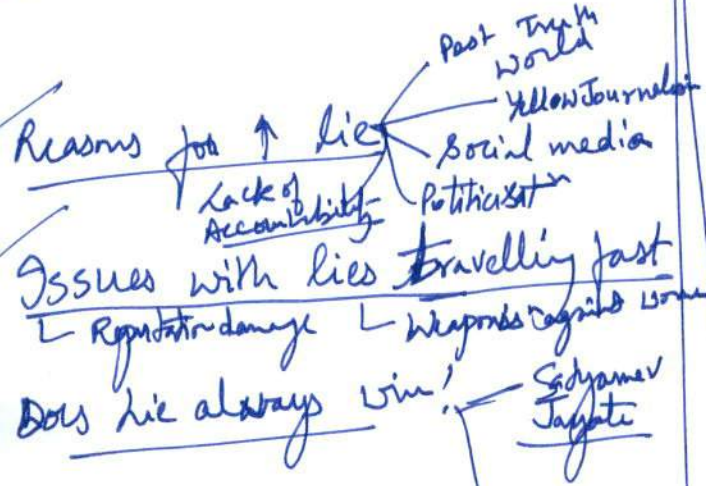
